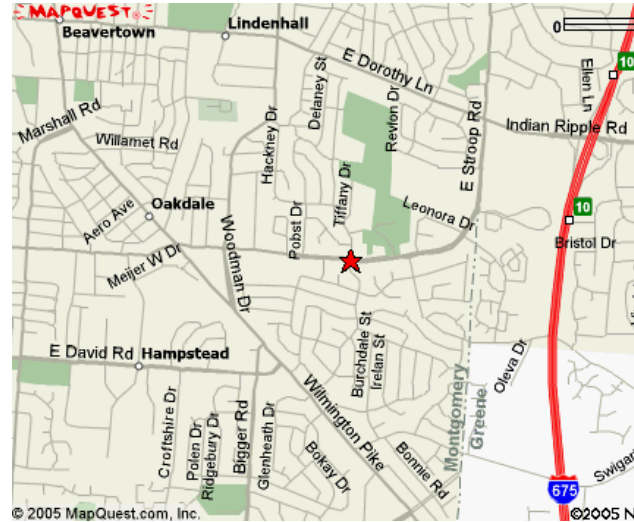
Goals of the FOPA

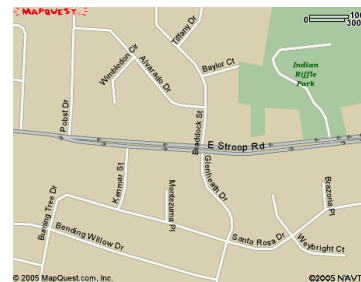

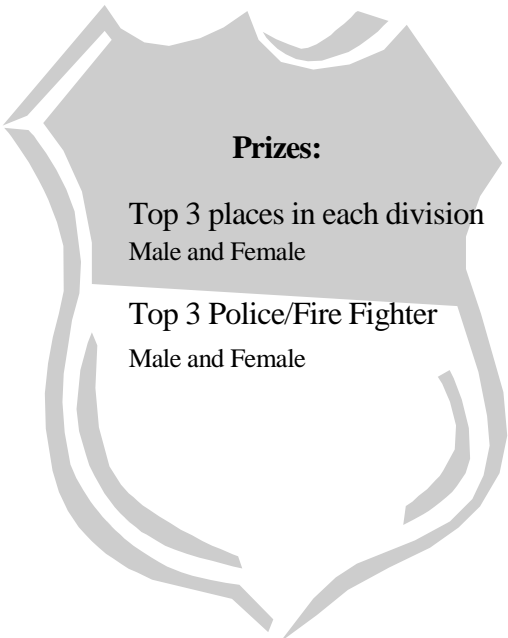
